Paris Campus

• Indoor training facilities equipped with Trackman technology.

These state-of-the-art amenities allow us to seamlessly combine athletic and academic training in one location. Our students benefit from an ideal environment where they can fully focus on achieving their goals.

To promote optimal learning, each student is granted unlimited access to the sports facilities and a personal locker, ensuring they can effortlessly balance their studies and training sessions.

A minimum handicap is required for admission to the school (refer to the "Admissions" page), and the program starts in the first year with intermediate to advanced-level training. If your handicap does not meet the requirements for the sports program, please contact our team for guidance.

The Ryder Tour

This journey will emphasize mastering the short game, particularly chipping and wedging. Students will also engage their digital skills by creating a vlog to document and share their experiences.

To obtain the complete application package, please send an email request to admission@pgb-school.com.

Your application file should include: Academic transcripts from previous years; Certificates of completion for exams (e.g., Baccalaureate or equivalent); Sports credentials (licenses, rankings, etc.); A cover letter outlining your goals and motivation for joining PGB School; Proof of identity; English proficiency documentation (official exam results if residing in a Francophone country)

SELECTION CRITERIA

The admissions panel evaluates each application based on the following:

- Motivation: Demonstrated commitment to golf and ambition to progress.
- Goals: Alignment between your athletic ambitions and professional aspirations.
- Academic Background: Evidence of your ability to succeed in a demanding program.
- English Proficiency: A good command of English is essential for academic success in an international environment.

MOTIVATION INTERVIEW

All candidates must complete a motivation interview conducted by the admissions panel. The interview, based on a personality assessment, lasts 25 to 45 minutes and is conducted via video conference (by invitation). The purpose of the interview is twofold: to understand the candidate's genuine motivations and to assess their academic and athletic personality

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To join the PGB School BBA program, you must meet the following criteria:

 Baccalaureate: Hold a Baccalaureate diploma or equivalent secondary education certification.
